

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, the Duke Power Company, at the request of the Greenville Airport Commission, proposes to erect an electric pole line to furnish power for obstruction lighting to the Greenville Airport, the pole line to approach the airport from a westerly direction up the valley between the northwest end of the NW/SE runway and the west end of the E/W runway, and to terminate at a point approximately 310 feet southwest of a stake, which stake is located on the west edge of the NW/SE runway and approximately 400 feet southeast of the northwest end of this runway; and,

WHEREAS, the Greenville Airport Commission proposes to install and maintain (first) an underground feeder from the termination point of the proposed line, extending underneath the NW/SE runway to buildings and trees lying on the east side of this runway, and (second) a feeder from the point where the proposed line crosses an existing road west of the termination point of said proposed line, which feeder will extend along said road partly underground and partly on poles to serve buildings immediately west of the E/W runway; and,

WHEREAS, the first feeder will provide electric service for property of major R. F. Watson, occupied by Felton Scott as tenant, and the second feeder will provide electric service for property of Major R. F. Watson, occupied by Homer Bibbs as tenant, and the meter for supplying service to the Watson property occupied by Felton Scott will be located at the termination of the proposed line, and the meter for supplying service to the Watson property occupied by Homer Bibbs will be located at the point where the second feeder leaves said proposed line;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the furnishing of said electric service by Duke Power Company to the said Felton Scott and Homer Bibbs, and to the premises of Major R. F. Watson, said service to be furnished in accordance with the rules and regulations of said Power Company, the said Felton Scott, Homer Bibbs and Major R. F. Watson contract and agree with Duke Power Company that Duke Power Company shall not be in any manner responsible for the delivery of said electric service beyond the location of the meters above mentioned, or either of them, nor for the maintenance of said feeder lines, or either of them, and that the said Felton Scott, Homer Bibbs and Major R. F. Watson will hold Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, harmless against any claims or demands or causes of action which may be asserted against said Duke Power Company, growing out of or in anywise connected with the delivery of electric service, or the failure to deliver such service, or any interruption of such service, to the said Felton Scott or Homer Bibbs or Major R. F. Watson's premises, and each of them, by means of said feeders, or either of them.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Felton Scott, <sup>Homer Bibbs</sup> and Major R. F. Watson have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals, this the 3rd day of Jan. 1941.
