All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the east side of Webster Street, in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 31 of Block D, as shown on a plat of the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Surrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Webster Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 31 and 32 of Block D, said pin also being 75 feet north from the northeast corner of the intersection of Webster and Edison Streets, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 32, N. 87-26 E. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 2, N. 2-3/4 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 30, S. 87-26 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Webster Street; thence with the east side of Webster Street S. 2-3/4 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is made to the grantee named in full satisfaction of that mortgage given by James D. Putman to S. Slater & Sons, Inc., for \$1075.00, dated November 1, 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgages Volume 297 at page 276.
