(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. C. Moon, his successors as trustee as hereinafter stated, and assigns forever:  
In trust for the uses and purposes hereinafter stated:  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the South side of the new Super Highway No. 29, and shown as lots Nos. 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, and 52 on a plat of the property of the grantors prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, June 24th, 1941, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on an unnamed street J. C. Moon's corner and running thence with said unnamed street S. 82-52 E. 544.1 feet to a stake on Line Street; thence N. 4-45 E. 67 feet to right of way of new Super Highway No. 29; thence with said right of way N. 85-00 W. 554.6 feet to an iron pin J. C. Moon's corner on right of way; thence S. 6-57 E. 48 feet to the beginning corner.

In trust, however, to and for the use and benefit of Mrs. Hettie Rushton, Annie Turner, Hubert Moon and Argyle Moon and James Moon, with power and authority to exchange, hypothecate, barter, sell and otherwise handle, manage, control and dispose of for the said cestui que trust, without accountability for such acts.
