DEED FOR ROAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. C. Harris in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for other valuable considerations, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the County of Greenville, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way, as hereinafter described, on and over all lands which we may own in whole or in part.

It is the intention of the Deed to convey such parts, parcels or strips of our land that may be needed to convey a right-of-way of sections of the White Horse Road Ext. Road, having the width of 36 ft. Feet, that is 18 ft. Feet on each side of the center line, as staked out by the Engineer, except where there should be a cut or fill, may be necessary for extra width. It is understood that center line of Road is on Center line of adjoining land owners.

This right of way beginning at on west side Fork Shoals Road near Miss Holliday property & adjoining lands of J. Rowly Henderson.

Provided:

That all obstructions on right of way are to be removed and fences that are on right of way are to be relocated, without expense to property owners.

This right of way is conditioned upon Greenville County Building and actually constructing the proposed highway; otherwise, this deed is void
