to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee (s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Minnie Mae Bowers, her heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Carolina Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 17 of Block I, Section No. 5, on plat of East Highlands Estates, made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 78, 79 and 80, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Carolina Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots No. 17 and 18 of Block I, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 18, S. 82-42 W. 187.4 feet to an iron pin on the East side of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the East side of said strip of land reserved for utilities, N. 7-23 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 16 of Block I, N. 82-39 E. 174.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Carolina Avenue; thence with the West side of Carolina Avenue, S. 17-49 E. 71.4 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the building restrictions and restrictive covenants applicable to the said lot, which are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 231, at page 1.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinafter named, and her heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

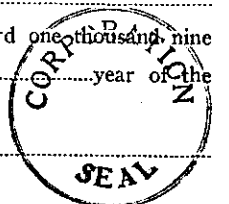
