for metes and bounds.

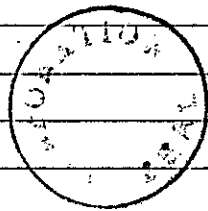
This is a portion of the property inherited by us from our father, Charles McAlister, deceased
