M. Scott and Pearl T. Scott

All those lots of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, on the northern side of National Highway (now known as Camp Road) and being shown as Lots Nos. 78x, 79x and 80x, of Block B, on plat of "Paris" made by R. E. Dalton, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 211, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the northern side of Camp Road, 40 feet east from Mooney Road, corner of Lot No. 77, and running thence with line of said lot, N. 37-23 W. 50 feet to a stake in line of Lot 81x; thence with line of said lot, N. 53-40 E. 60.4 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 5; thence with line of said lot, S. 37-11 E. 50 feet to Camp Road; thence with the northern side of Camp Road, S. 53-40 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner, being a part of the property conveyed to Realty Corporation by D. B. Traxler by deed dated April 7, 1931, recorded in Volume 16, page 88, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

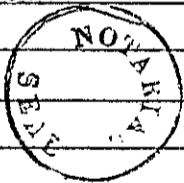
