NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Charles L. Hightower, Jr., George W. Hightower, Hodges Hightower, Louise E. Hightower, Kathleen H. Poole, and Harry Lee Chapman.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on both sides of the Greenville Hendersonville Highway containing 242.74 acres, being all of the tract of land described in a deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book XX at page 247, which according to said deed contained 300 acres and which according to a recent survey contains 307.74 acres, except the portion containing 65 acres conveyed this day by E. Inman, Master, to Wilton Earle Hightower, et al. It being the intention hereby to convey to the grantees herein the entire tract described in the deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book XX at page 247, which the exception of the 65 acres tract above referred to.
