I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Cora S. Wood, Mary Lee Gilstrap, Louie Wood, Ernest Wood, Beulah W. McCall,
Ralph Wood and Margaret W. Chandler

on or about the 7 day of August in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-two exhibited complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Kyle Wood

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 27
day of August, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to W. W. Sullivan

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. _____)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid
decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said W. W. Sullivan

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in the
County and State aforesaid, and being known as tract #9 of the division of the Huff Lands,
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Garrison's line, and running thence S. 64 1/2 E. 5.45 to a
stake; thence N. 72 E. 26.37 to a stake; thence N. 59 1/2 E. 13.00 to a stake; thence N. 37 1/2 W.
7.00 to a Flint Pile; thence S. 73 W. 25.50 to a stake; thence S. 6.50 to a stake; thence S.
72 W. 14.15 to the beginning corner, containing 36 1/2 acres, more or less, according to a plat
of J. Wister Stewart, dated December 19, 1902.

Being the same property conveyed to J. H. Wood by W. G. Rambo by deed dated Dec.
16, 1922 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 87 at page 117.
