TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, J. W. Simonton as Administrator, J. A. Talbert and H. D. Caldwell, Individually and as Administrators of the Estate of Mrs. Eugenia R. Juhan, and Mrs. Mary M. Simonton, etal,

on or about the 2nd day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-two exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Mrs. Rosella T. Edmunds and all other unknown heirs at law, distributees and/or next kin, whether minors or adults and/or non compos mentis or sui juris, and any and all other persons whether resident or non-resident of the State of South Carolina claiming any interest in the Estate of Mrs. Eugenia R. Juhan, individually and collectively designated as John Doe,

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of December, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Twenty-five (\$1225.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said Tommie C. Putman

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Tommie C. Putman

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 47, according to plat of Pride & Patton Land Company, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded in Plat Book "E", at Page 249, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, said lot having a frontage of 60 feet on the North side of Heatherly Drive, with a depth on one side of 218.1 feet and 212.2 feet on the other, and is the same property conveyed to Southern Investment Corp., by J.
