All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Glassy Mountain Township, on the South side of the Glassy Mountain road, adjoining lands of John Emory and Mrs. Ora Turner, and being a part of the same tract of land conveyed to me by Callie Pitman by deed dated the   ✓   day of   ✓   1929 and having the following distances and courses, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mt. Township,   ✓   County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at an iron pin, on the East bank of Creek (stone gone) John Emory's corner, and runs thence N. 62-15 E. 396 feet to a stone, John Emory's corner; thence N. 2-45 E. 457.5 feet to an iron pin in the Glassy Mountain road; thence with said road S. 75-20 W. 100 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 40-10 W. 100 feet to another bend in said road; thence S. 26-30 W. 200 feet to another bend in said road; thence S. 60-30 W. 100 feet to another bend in said road; thence S. 79-00 W. 94 feet to the center of a bridge over the creek; thence down said creek S. 9-00 E. 100 feet to a bend in creek; thence S. 27-26 W. 60 feet to another bend in creek; thence S. 26-00 E. 159 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Three and Forty-Six One Hundredths acres, more or less.
