Greene, Everett Greene, Annie G. League, Gertrude G. Howell, John Greene, Alvin Greene, Malvin
Greene, Lottie G. Verdin and Myrtle G. Eskew,

All the right, title and interest of the Defendant, Stella Greene in and to the
following described real estate:

"All that certain tract of land in Butler Township, State and County aforesaid
containing 312.16 acres, more or less, and being known as the John L. Greene and Annie L.
Greene lands. Said tract is bounded on the North by lands now or formerly of J. A. Greene,
