M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 257, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Georgia Avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, which point is 82.8 feet north of the northeast corner of the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Georgia Avenue, and running thence along the joint line of Lots 1 and 2, N. 71-00 E. 178.2 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of the P. & N.
