Mrs. J. H. Alewine, G. W. Alewine and Ansel Alewine, Partners trading as Taylors Lumber Company,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, containing something over eleven acres, more or less, made up of Lots  
numbered twenty-seven (27) to thirty-four (34), inclusive, on H. S. Broakman's plat of the lands  
of Southeastern Life Insurance Company, dated September 25, 1936, and having according to said  
plat, the following metes and bounds in the aggregate: Beginning at a point in the center of  
the bridge by which the Old Rutherford Road crosses Enoree River and running thence down the  
center of said river, following the meanders thereof as the line, approximately as follows: S.  
14 E. 260 feet; S. 73-30 E. 100 feet; N. 87 E. 600 feet; S. 86-45 E. 200 feet; N. 40-30 E. 100  
feet; N. 11-25 E. 437 feet to a stake on the north bank of said river; thence N. 80 E. 117 feet  
to a stake approximately in the middle of said river, on the old highway; thence with said old

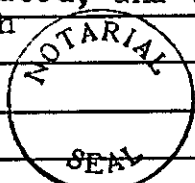
