TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Sallie Lister,

on or about the 24th day of October in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-two exhibited her complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Gaston Lister, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th
day of February, 1943, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to Vaught Lister

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. -----)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid
decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Vaught Lister

"All that parcel, tract or lot of land, lying and being on both sides of a public
road leading from Tigerville toward Callaham Mountain, and on mail route No. 1 from Taylors,
being in Highland Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, adjoining land of
Johnson on the East, Vaught Lister on the S. E. and lands of the late A. J. Lister on the South
and West, and beginning at an iron pin in a grove of pines, on land of the late A. J. Lister,
and runs thence N. 28 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 9.08 chains to an iron pin in edge of woods; thence N. 61 E. 4.92 chains
to iron pin, Johnson line corner in center of above named road; thence S. 20.3 E. 7.80 chains to
iron pin in old road bed; thence S. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 4.14 chains to a point in center of above named road;
thence N. 78 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 3.64 chains to the beginning corner, and containing 4.57 acres, more or less,
according to survey by J. Earle Freeman, September 30, 1938. See Deed recorded in Book 115, page 46."
