I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, L. M. Davis and James H. Davis

on or about the 30th day of April in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-three exhibited their complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Raymond Davis and Ray Davis

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15th
day of June, 1943, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to U. L. Hudson

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. -----)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid
decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said U. L. Hudson

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville
County, South Carolina, in Chick Springs Township, on the Rutherford Road, adjoining lands of
Miller, Stokes and Wynn, having the following courses and distances: Beginning on an iron pin
in the said Rutherford Road, Stokes' corner, and running thence with the said road N. 24-10 W.
358 feet to an iron pin in west side of said road; thence S. 81-30 W. 641 feet to an iron pin
on the Miller line; thence with the Miller line S. 73-30 E. 812 feet to beginning corner, con-
taining two and one half (2.50) acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to J. M. Davis by
R. L. Wynn by deed dated July 10, 1936, recorded in Book 182, page 251. The purchase price being
Seven Hundred Dollars.
