

POWER OF ATTORNEY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Robert P. Walters, a resident of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being now in the military service of the United States, do make, constitute and appoint my brother, Chalmers S. Walters, of said City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact for me and in my name, place and stead:

To demand, sue for and receive all debts, moneys, securities, goods and other personal property to which I am now or may hereafter be entitled or which are now or may become due, owing or payable to me, and in my name to give effectual receipts releases and discharges for the same;

To represent me in the administration of the estate of my mother, Annie T. (Mrs. R. P.) Walters, giving to my said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do everything necessary in the administration of said estate as fully as I myself would be able to do were I personally present, including full power and authority to collect for me any money or other property from the said estate and execute in my name full and complete receipts, releases and discharges of any interest that I may have in said estate.

And generally to act as my attorney or agent in relation to the premises, and all other matters in which I may be interested or concerned, and on my behalf to execute all necessary instruments and to do all such acts and things as fully and effectually in all respects as I myself could do if personally present.

I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators ratify and confirm, whatsoever my said attorney shall do by virtue of these presents.
