All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being one of the tracts of the property of William Goldsmith and W. C. Walker, and what was formerly known as Addie Hill Place, containing 20.1 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on or near the Duncan Road, just across property of W. D. Parrish and T. C. Gower, and running thence N. 11-12 W. 178 ft. to stake; thence S. 74-10 W. 237 ft. to stake; S. 84-34 W. 2022 ft. more or less, to a stake; thence S. 46-32 E. 68 ft. to stone, twin po.; thence S. 27-35 E. 197.7 ft. to stone; thence S. 57-13 E. 132.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 61-64 E. 622.4 ft. to a stone corner of J.
