

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT I, Frank Walker Childers domiciled and residing at Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact, to act for me and on my behalf on all matters in which I may have an interest, do hereby nominate, appoint and constitute Frances Walker Childers of Greenville, South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power to sell, transfer, exchange or otherwise dispose of any of my property, real, personal or mixed and to execute and deliver good and sufficient deeds or other instruments for the conveyance or transfer of the same; to collect, sue, compromise or otherwise dispose of any claim or debt to which I now or hereafter may have an interest; to pay, compromise or otherwise discharge and secure releases from any obligations or claims against me; to deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker, or trust company all moneys which may come to HIS/HER hands as such attorney and all bills of exchange, drafts, checks, promissory notes, and other securities for money payable or belonging to me, and for that purpose to sign my name and indorse the same for deposit or collection, and from time to time withdraw any or all moneys deposited with the aforesaid bank, banker or trust company or any other banking institution having moneys belonging to me, and for the purpose to draw checks in my name; to execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and Army Regulations, and to receive, endorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned, drawn on the Treasurer of the United States.

FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid attorney-in-fact to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorizations and generally to do any and all acts on my behalf on any other matter or thing pertaining or belonging to me with the same validity as I could effect, if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said attorney shall and may do by virtue hereof, in the premises.

FURTHER, this power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by me.
