to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto T. E. Mitchell, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of Carolina Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 5, Block J, Section 5, on plat of East Highlands Estates, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 78, 79 and 80, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Carolina Avenue at joint front corner of Lots No. 4 and 5 of Block J, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 4, N. 77-45 E. 189.6 feet to an iron pin on the West side of a five foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along the West side of said five foot strip reserved for utilities, S. 00-24 E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 6, S. 83-44 W. 177 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Carolina Avenue; thence with the East side of Carolina Avenue, N. 8-28 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants set forth in instrument dated February 26th, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 231, at page 1.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

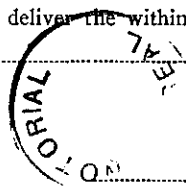
