All that certain lot parcel or piece of land lying being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and in the Town of Fountain Inn and on the West side of Main Street; beginning at an iron pin corner of J. W. Givens' lot on Main Street; running thence along said Street 33 1/3 feet to corner formerly owned by the Baptist Church now owned by Mrs. Flora Far Templeton; thence running along said Templeton line 75 feet; thence running across said Templeton line 33 1/3 feet to the J. W. Givens Brick Wall; thence along J. W. Givens Brick Wall 75 feet to the beginning corner on Main Street.
