All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the north-west side of the Taylors-O'Neal Road, and beginning in the center of said road at a point 300 feet south of the Emma Lewis corner in said road, and runs thence N. 48-40 W. 1350 feet to iron pin; thence N. 20-30 E. 300 feet to the line of the Emma Lewis property; thence with her line, N. 48-40 W. 778 feet to a stone, cornering with Tom Greer; thence with his line, S. 41-40 W. 975 feet to iron pin on line of lot No. 2 on plat herein referred to; thence S. 53-30 (plus-minus) E. 1400 feet to a stone; thence S. 63-30 E. 1054 feet to iron pin in said road; thence with center of said road, N. 15-15 E. 300 feet to angle; thence N. 20-30 E. 35 to the beginning corner, containing thirty-two and 39/100 (32.39) acres, more or less; and being part of tract No. 1 of the original J.
