

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, BY THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Martha Park and Lillias Park, both of Greenwood, S. C.,

did on the 13th day of January, 1941, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

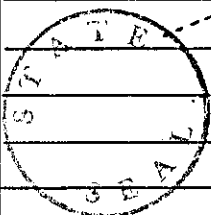
FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Martha Park, Inc.,

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenwood, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is buy and sell merchandise and any and all other kinds of personal property, and particularly the right to engage in the buying and selling of merchandise at retail, and the said corporation shall have all the powers that may be granted unto a corporation

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT Pursuant to law, the Capital Stock of the within Corporation has been this day increased to the sum of \$25,000.00 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars given to me under my hand and the Seal of the State at Columbia, this 26th day of June 1944. Increase recorded this 26th day of June 1944 at 10:42 A.M. Ollie James on the R.M. 6740 State of South Carolina Secretary of State June 28, 1944. Acts of the General Assembly that the Secretary of State has been notified that the records on the records are cancelled.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars,

payable in cash or in merchandise

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50) Dollars of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

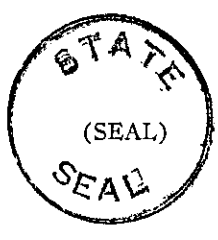
SEVENTH: That after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 11th day of January, 1941, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: Martha Park and Lillias Park.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected, as President Martha Park as Vice-President, Lillias Park; as Secretary, Martha Park; as Treasurer, Martha Park.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1937 and its amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent, of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

The Index-Journal Greenwood a newspaper published in the County of Greenwood

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
