IN THE EVENT of the death of a party hereto, the surviving co-partner shall within a period of four weeks, make and give, to the legal representative of the deceased co-partner, a true, just and final account of all things relating to the co-partnership business, and within a period of three months, in all things truly adjust the same with the legal representative of the deceased co-partner. The surviving co-partner shall have the privilege of purchasing the interest of the deceased co-partner from his legal representative, upon a true and proper valuation of the interest of the deceased co-partner; and until the purchase of said interest by the surviving co-partner, or a division as herein agreed upon, the legal representative of the deceased co-partner during reasonable business hours shall have access to the books of the co-partnership and examine same personally or with the aid of other persons and make copies thereof or any portion thereof without any interruption or hindrance, and the said legal representative of said deceased co-partner shall have equal and joint control of the said co-partnership with the surviving partner or partners.

This instrument may not be changed orally.
