All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Hubert Street of the City of Greer, adjoining lots, now or formerly, of W. C. Watkins and T. G. Edwards, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at pin on Hubert Street, and runs thence N. 16-3/4 E. 130 feet and thence N. 73 1/4 W. 62 feet; thence S. 16 3/4 W. 130 feet to Hubert Street, thence S. 73 1/4 E. 62 feet along Hubert Street to the beginning corner, and being a part of the same conveyed to Sallie G.
