Beginning at an iron pin on the northern corner of tract of land containing two acres, more or less, conveyed to R. M. Bishop and Dora Bishop by E. Inman, Master, by deed recorded in R. M. C. Office in Book 59 at Page 84 and in line of Judson Mill land and running thence with line of Judson Mill Land S. 52-3 W. 215 feet to a stake, corner of unnamed (now Scott) street and thence with said unnamed Street in southeasterly direction fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence, in a northeasterly direction 206 1/4 feet, more or less, to line of Judson Mill land thence, N. 55 W. forty (40) feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the tract of land conveyed in deed aforesaid.
