(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mildred Pollard, her Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being bounded on the North by lands formerly of S. D. Mosteller Estate, on the East by lands of S. H. Burnett and B. W. Burnett and others, on the South by lands of Mrs. Rosa West, and on the West by Mrs. Mamie Burnett, and lying on the northern side of the Ansel School Road, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed from R. B. Wood March 9th, 1920 and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 63 at page 547, and containing according to said deed Twenty Six and Three Fourth (26 3/4) Acres, more or less: LESS HOWEVER various lots conveyed by me at various times as follows:

- ✓ In 1941 lot of One acre to Mae Pierce;
- ✓ In 1942 lot of Eighty Nine One-hundredths of one acre to Mae Pierce;
- ✓ In 1942 lot of One Acre and Three One-hundredths (1.03) to Carl Loftis;
- ✓ In May of 1941 lot of One and Twenty Nine One-hundredths (1.29) Acres to Eula Pollard

In December 4th 1936 lot of One and Twenty Three One-hundredths (1.23) Acres to Eber Pollard, deed recorded in Greenville County, RMC Office in Deed Book 191 at page 222.

Thus leaving a net acreage being conveyed in this deed of Twenty One and Thirty One One-hundredths (21.31) Acres, more or less.
