KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J. B. League, A. D. Asbury, William F. Jackson, Brown Mahon, G. L. McCullough, W. T. Potter, C. R. Babb and Dr. J. G. Murray, as Trustees for the School District of the City of Greenville, South Carolina - - - - -

in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100 - - - - -

to us paid by Violet H. Lollis - - - - -

in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Violet H. Lollis

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the City of Greenville on the North Side of John Street, adjoining the lot on which the John Street School is located and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of John Street and the 14 ft. alley, which pin is 184.3 ft. from Butler Avenue; thence with John Street N. 64-54 W. 50 ft. to an iron pin corner of John Street School lot; thence with line of that lot N. 21 E. 127 ft. to an iron pin on the 16 ft. alley; thence with line of said alley S. 57-38 E. 52 ft. to an iron pin on said 14 ft. alley; thence with said alley in a Southwesterly direction 120 ft. to the beginning corner; said lot being bounded on the South by John Street; on the West by John Street School lot and on the North and East sides by alleys.

The above described lot is a portion of the lot conveyed to the Trustees of said School District by John O. Donaldson, T. Q. Donaldson, Nannie D. Furman and Sarah E. Barnes by deed dated July 31, 1929, and recorded in Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 148 Page 153.

Grantor agrees to pay all taxes for 1945.
