REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, I, William Harold Hammett, of near Greer in the County and State aforesaid, did, on the 21st day of August, 1944, execute unto my brother, Eugene E. Hammett, my power of attorney, under which he was authorized and empowered to do and perform various and sundry acts in my name and stead. Said power of attorney was in writing and is recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in deed book 276, page 168, and reference is made thereto for determination of the powers conferred. At the time of the execution of said instrument I was in the Armed Services of the United States and for that reason was unable to transact my business to the full extent desired and necessary in some instances.

NOW, having returned to my civilian status and having full freedom to transact my business as formerly and there being no proper reason why I should retain said Eugene E. Hammett as my agent and attorney-in-fact, I do by these presents revoke, recall and declare null and void said power of attorney as of this date; but in doing so I ratify and confirm any and all acts previously done and performed by the said Eugene E. Hammett for me and in my stead by reason of the authority conferred upon him in said instrument.

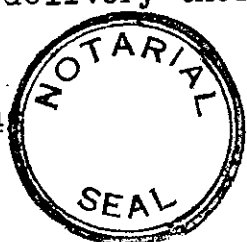
