WHEREAS, in April, 1929, the heirs of J. F. C., conveying the right, title, and interest in a certain lot or tract of land; and whereas, Mae Bridgeman, one of the heirs, was then under age but has since became of age, is married and is now Mae Bridgeman Huntsinger and desires to convey her right, title and interest to said lot of land as was done by the other heirs of J. F. Bridgeman; and whereas she has received a deed for her portion of said estate; and whereas Amanda Gosnell has transferred her interest under said deed to her husband, Belton Gosnell.

NOW THEREFORE:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mae Bridgeman Huntersinger of Polk County, State of North Carolina

in consideration of the sum of ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ one and no/100 Dollars, the premises the division of and partition in kind of the lands of J. F. Bridgeman ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Belton Gosnell

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Belton Gosnell, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of my undivided right, title, and interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at Sherman McClures corner on the North side of the Spartanburg-Asheville Highway and runs thence N. 16 E. 382.1 feet to stake; thence S. 67.55 E. 171 feet to stake, corner of J. Ed Bridgeman land; thence S. 16 W. 382.1 feet to iron pin on said Highway, thence along said Highway N. 67.55 W 171 feet to the beginning, containing 1.5 acres, more or less.
