in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Casper Harris

All those two lots located in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 7-I and being designated as Lot s Nos. 28 and 40 of Nickletown Heights #2, according to a plat on record in the R. M. C. Office in Plat Book M, at Page 5 and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Pine Street at the corner of Lot #27 and thence running along said street S. 34 E. 40 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot #29; thence S. 56 W. 240 feet to an iron pin on the north side of River Street; thence along the line of River Street N. 34 W. 40 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot #39; thence N. 56 E. 240 feet to an iron pin on Pine Street at the beginning corner.
