All that piece, parcel or lot of land in x Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and better known and designated as Lots Nos. eighty-four (84) and eighty five (85), in Section number one (1) of the property known as Nickle-Town Heights. Originally surveyed by C. M. Furman, Jr., in 1922 (see Plat Book "F", at page 68). These were checked and revised by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in March, 1941, and recorded in Plat Book "F", at page 68, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, to which plat and the record thereof reference is hereby made.
