in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said N. O. McDowell, Jr., and W. T. Henderson, their heirs and assigns forever,  
All my right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Pine Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 6 and 6A of Block H on Plat of Woodville Heights, made by W. J. Riddle, in November, 1939, recorded in Plat Book K at Page 275, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Pine Street, corner of Lot No. 5, and running thence with the line of Lots Nos. 5 and 5A, N. 54-15 W. 476 feet to a stake; thence S. 35-05 W. 90 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 7A; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 7A and 7, S. 53-40 E. 478.3 feet to a stake on Pine Street; thence with the Western side of Pine Street, N. 36-20 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
