I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Thomas R. Moore, as Guardian for William T. Moore and Nancy Gertrude Moore

on or about the 25th day of August in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-five exhibited his complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against William T. Moore, Nancy Gertrude Moore and Greenville County, a  
Municipal Corporation

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the X  
day of June, 19 46, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for  
the County aforesaid, to Ted Greene

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-10411)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid  
decree, **and upon receipt of \$1250.00**

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said  
Ted Greene

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being in Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, near the Town of Simpsonville, lying and being between the Old Laurens  
Road and the C. & W. C. Railroad, containing 13.67 acres, more or less, and beginning at a stone  
on the Old Laurens Road and running thence N. 79½ E. 12.60 to stone near railroad; thence up the  
railroad 15.18 to a stone; thence S. 52½ W. 12.40 to stone on west bank of Laurens Road; thence  
down said road to beginning corner: EXCEPT HOWEVER, from the course and distance description  
a parcel of 2.23 acres previously conveyed away. Said lot or parcel is the same as is second  
described in a deed from E. Inman, Master to William T. Moore and Nancy Gertrude Moore by a deed  
recorded in Book 243, Page 9, Office R. M. C., Greenville County save and except the acreage  
previously mentioned as having been conveyed away."
