and in the Town of Taylors, being known and designated as Lots Five, Six, Seven and Eight on a subdivision of Lot No. One of property of W. M. Shockley, deceased, as shown by subdivision and plat of the same made by Thomas T. Linder, November 10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book F, Page 45, reference to which plat is hereby made as a part of this description; Lot No. Five has a frontage of 27.7 feet on the South side of the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 140.5 feet on one side and 142 feet on the other side and has a width in the rear of 28 feet; Lot No. Six fronts 27.7 feet on the South side of the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 142 feet on one side and 144 feet on the other, with a rear line of 28 feet; Lot No. Seven has a frontage on the South side of the National Highway of 27.6 feet and runs back in parallel lines 144 feet on one side and 146 feet on the other, with a rear line of 28 feet; Lot No. Eight has a frontage of 27.7 feet on the South side of the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 146 feet on one side and 151 feet on the other, with a rear line of 28 feet. The rear of each of said lots extends along the right of way of the Southern Railroad.
