E. L. Field, as Deacons of Associated Reformed Presbyterian Church.

All the right, title and interest of Tommyruth Goudelock, the same being an
undivided one-eighth interest in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain lot of land in the northern portion of the City of Greenville,
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of
Greenville, fronting on Chick Springs Road, and being more particularly described by metes
and bounds, as follows:
