"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the intersection of the Augusta and Fork Shoals Roads, and having the following metes and bounds according to survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, May 1, 1935:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Fork Shoals Road at the northeast corner of the tract belonging to H. W. Chiles, and running thence with line of Chiles property S. 56 W. 102 feet, thence N. 50-45 W. 148 feet to point in the center of Augusta Road, thence along the center of the Augusta Road N. 35 E. 216 feet to point in the intersection of the Augusta and the Fork Shoals Roads; thence along the center of the Fork Shoals Road in a southerly direction to the beginning corner, being a portion of the property devised to Mary I. Meadors by her husband, A. R. Meadors."
