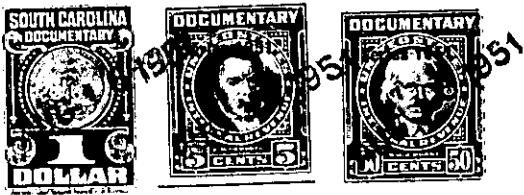

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate and being in
Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing
14 acres, according to a plat made by W.A. Hester, August 18, 1945
The same is recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in
Flat Book "O", at page 197 and has the following metes and bounds,
To Wit;

BEGINNING at wn Iron Pin on a new road and running thence North
25 East 15.00 along Mr Looper's land to an Iron Pin in Branch; thence
following a gully the gully being the line, North 41/2 West 1.30 to a
bend ; Thence North 40 1/2 West 1.18 to a bend ; Thence North 66 West 1.78
to a bend ; Thence North 84 West 1.73 to a bend , thence North 83 West
1.87 to a bend; Thence, South 81 1/2 West 2.37 to a bend; thence North
88 West 1.66 to an Iron Pin, the corner of Henry Burn or the Duckett
lands, thence South 25 West 10.60 to a stake in new road; thence South
39 East 3.47 to a bend in new Road; thence South 51 East 5.14 to Bend in Road
61 East 2.06 to an Iron Pin, the beginning corner and is bounded by the
lands owned by Rudolph Looper, Styles , , walter Looper , and land now
owned or formerly owned by Henry Burns
