edged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
A.H. Campbell and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land containing 3.22 Acres, more or less, situated on the West side of the surfaced road leading from Lenoah School community to Pleasant Hill, about ten miles Northward from Greer, in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a part of the Dunahoo place, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Doyle Poole, J.W. Barbare and others, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point in said road, southeast corner of said lot, and running thence N. 64.45 W. 413.5 feet to pine; thence N. 14.57 E. 352 feet to stake in big gully; thence along the gully, S. 55.44 E. 164.8 feet to stake; thence S. 58.49 E. 333 feet to center of said road; thence along said road, S. 30.03 W. 200 feet to bend; thence along said road, S. 24.48 W. 86.5 feet to the beginning corner.
