Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Agnes S. Dawsey, of Greenville County,

in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and No/100 - - - - - (\$3,000.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantees, Robert H. Stewart, Jr. and Margaret C. Stewart, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 88, of a subdivision known as Stone Lake Heights, Section No. 2, as shown on plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 15, 1953, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 87, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western edge of Merimac Court, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 88 and 89, and running thence along the western edge of Merimac Court, following the curvature thereof, the chord of which is N. 5-50 E. 102.1 feet, to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots 87 and 88; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 81-39 W. 154.9 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot 103; thence along the rear line of Lots 103 and 102, S. 19-27 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot 102; thence continuing along the rear line of Lot 102, S. 2-52 W. 20 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 101 and 102; thence along the joint line of Lots 88 and 89, S. 86-43 E. 177 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to restrictions and protective covenants recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 483, at page 355, and is also subject to certain easements or rights-of-way for the installation and maintenance of public utilities, which easements also appear of record in said R. M. C. office.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

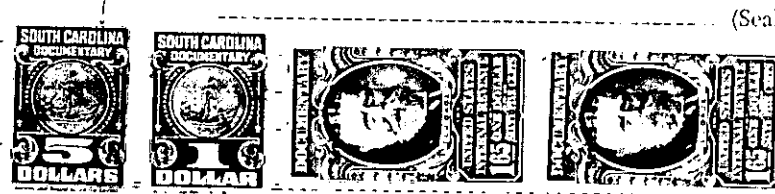
