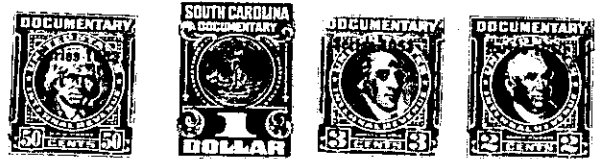

-----Dollars, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. P. STEVENS & CO., INC.:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Whitney Street at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 2, Block N, as shown on a plat entitled "Plat Showing Property Owned by Slater Manufacturing Co., Slater, S. C." made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, December 15, 1951, revised February 25, 1952, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book CC, at page 3, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Whitney Street at the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, and running thence along the common line of said two lots S. 57-30 E. 225 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of a 15 foot service alley; thence along the Western side of said alley N. 21-04 E. 251.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 2 and 3; thence along the common line of said two lots N. 88-05 W. 225 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Whitney Street; thence along the Eastern side of Whitney Street S. 9-55 W. 26 feet; thence continuing along the Eastern side of Whitney Street S. 22-41 W. 49 feet; thence still along the Eastern side of Whitney Street S. 32-30 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
