The above styled cause is an action for divorce which was commenced by the issuance and filing of a summons and complaint in the Clerk's Office for the County of Greenville above said on the 30th. day of March, 1950; that the said defendant was duly served with a copy of the summons and complaint on the 13th. day of April, 1950, as appears by affidavit of service on the back of the original summons; that more than 21 days have elapsed since said service and that no answer, admission or notice of appearance has been filed by or on behalf of said defendant as appears by affidavit of J. G. Leatherwood, attorney for plaintiff.

That a hearing was had before me this 23rd. day of April, 1950, the plaintiff being present in person and by her attorney, J. G. Leatherwood, the said defendant was not present and did file no answer, admission or notice of appearance; and at said hearing, testimony was taken regarding the allegations set forth in the complaint, a transcript of same being taken, reduced and filed of record.

The plaintiff testified as to the truth of the allegations contained in her complaint, which testimony was corroborated in some of the material respects by other witnesses.
