BUILDING RESTRICTIONS OR PROTECTIVE COVENANTS APPLICABLE TO LOTS NUMBERS SEVEN (7) TO THIRTY-FOUR (34) INCLUSIVE AND NUMBERS FORTY (40) TO ONE HUNDFED ONE (101) INCLUSIVE OF MCSWAIN CARDETS, THE PROPERTY OF THE ESTATE OF J. J. McSWAIN, ACCORDING TO A PLAT OF PLCCED IN THE R.M.C. OFFICE FOR GREETVILLE COUNTY IN PLAT BOOK GG AT PAGE 75.

The following building restrictions or protective covenants are hereby imposed by the undersigned, the owner of Lots Lunters 7 through 34 inclusive and Numbers 40 to 101 inclusive of McSwain Gardens, according to a plat of record in the R. M. C. Office for Creenville County in Plat Eook GG at Page 75.

These Covenants are to run with the land and shall be birdin on all persons claiming under them until January 1, 1980, at which time said Covenants shall be automatically extended for successive ricds of ten years unless by vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change said Covenants in whole or in part.

If the parties hereto, or any of them, or their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the Covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any person or persons owning any real property situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such Covenant and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation. Invalidation of any orm of these Covenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

- 1. These lots shall be used solely and exclusively for simple-family residential dwellings.
- 2. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any initative plot in this subdivision until the building plans, specifications, and plot plan showing the location of such building have been expressed in writing as to conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures in the subdivision, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation, by a condition of the building with posed of John F. Chandler, Wm. R. Timmons, Jr., and W. T. ratrick, or by a representative designated by a majority of the members of sold admitter. In the event of the death or resignation of any member of sold admitter, the remaining member or members shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such design and location, or to designate a representation of the event of the event said committee, or its designated representative, fails to approve or disapprove such design and location it takes.
