This agreement made this the 27th day of September, 1954, by and between Lillie C. Thompson, hereinafter called the seller, and Moseley, hereinafter called the purchaser,

W I T N E S S E T H:

That in and for the consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 - (\$2,000.00) Dollars, to be paid as follows: One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars in cash upon the signing and delivery of this contract; and Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars to be paid as soon as the roof has been put upon the house to be constructed thereon. The seller agrees to sell, and the purchaser agrees to buy, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Town of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision of the property of Lillie C. Thompson as shown on plat thereof made by C. L. Thompson, and filed on September 28, 1951 and revised January 14, 1953 in the office of the Clerk of the M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, page 11, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of the driveway leading to the Greenville Air Force Base at the corner of 1st Street and 1st Avenue running thence along the west side of the driveway for a distance of 100 feet to an iron pin at the front corner of Lot No. 1; thence along the line of that lot 5' 10-1/2" 216.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 1; thence thence along the line of that lot, 17' 0-5/8" 51' 10-1/2" to the rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of that lot 17' 0-5/8" 51' 10-1/2" back to the beginning corner.

It is agreed and understood that the property it is agreed to subject to the following restrictions: that the same hereinabove described shall not be used for any other purpose than the construction of a residence thereon and such other purposes as may be required by law. The use of said property shall be such which might contribute to the welfare of the community.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERTAKEN by the seller to cause to commence immediately the construction of a house on the above described lot and is to finance same as soon as possible and in every way assist in the purchase price thereon.

Should the purchaser fail to commence the construction of the house at the time this contract is to become valid and void in law, the property thereon to be forfeited to the seller or rented at a reasonable price.
