tingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described property, to-wit: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 51.71 acres, more or less, according to plat of property of John E. Baskin, prepared by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, dated January 13, 1953, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.
