

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Five and no/100-----(\$10,275.00)----- Dollars,

to me paid by the said M. C. Woodson

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. C. Woodson

1. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on a branch tributary to Saluda River, said tract being Tract No. 1 of the land of the Estate of Azariah Woodson, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat made by W. L. Mitchell, Reg. Sur., on Oct. 12, 1922: BEGINNING at the Southwestern corner of said tract, said corner being in a branch, and running thence N. 18 W. 11.40 to a stake, thence N. 61 W. 1.50 to a point, thence N. 23 7/8 E. 20.00 to a point, thence S. 86 1/4 E. 5.31 to a stake, thence N. 20 7/8 E. 11.23 to a stake on line of H. F. Woodson, thence S. 74 E. 6.76 to a stake on line of Tract No. 5, thence S. 16 W. 3.03 to a stake, thence S. 74 1/4 E. 3.31, thence S. 15 1/5 W. 13.98 along line of H. F. Woodson, thence S. 55 W. 12.54 to a stake, thence S. 15 3/4 E. 9.63 to a branch, thence S. 76 W. 7.00 to a point in branch, thence in a Southwesterly direction along said branch to the beginning corner, containing 50 1/2 acres, more or less.
2. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, being made up of Tract No. 5 and Tract No. 6 of the Estate of Azariah Woodson, deceased, and in the aggregate having the following metes and bounds according to plats made by W. L. Mitchell, Reg. Sur. October 12, 1922: BEGINNING at a stake at the joint corner of Tract No. 5, Tract No. 1 and lands of H. F. Woodson, thence N. 3 3/4 E. 22.00 to a stake on line of Tract No. 7, thence S. 85 1/4 E. 6.85 to a stake on north prong of Rocky Fork, thence S. 52 1/8 E. 5.24 to a stake on south prong of Rock Fork, thence following the meanderings of said south prong to a point on line of C. J. Woodson, thence S. 26.3 W. 20.63 to a stake, thence S. 79 1/2 W. 4.56, thence N. 81 1/4 W. 8.66 to a stake, thence N. 74 W. 5.42 to the beginning corner, containing 59.2 acres, more or less.
3. All that tract or parcel of land in the County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING on stone in road and running thence S. 15 W. 17 to stone, thence S. 55 W. 12.50 to stone, thence S. 16 1/2 E. 9.60 to branch, thence up branch N. 84 E. 7.57 to point on branch, thence N. 75 degrees E. 4.28 to stone, thence N. 18 1/2 E. 30.50 to stone on road, thence N. 82 W. 7.64 to stone, thence N. 69 W. 1.26 to beginning corner, containing 29.4 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of James F. Willis, Sur. dated Nov. 23, 1908.
4. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 20 acres, more or less, in the County and State aforesaid, and in Dunklin Township, lying on Pelzer Road and being bounded on the North, East and South by lands formerly of Azariah Woodson and on the West by land formerly of Mrs. Emily Jordan, as shown on plat of J. M. Cox, Sur., dated Oct. 24, 1907.
5. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 1 acre, more or less, in the County and State aforesaid, and in Dunklin Township, lying on the Pelzer Road and being bounded on the North by lands formerly of Azariah Woodson, on the East by land formerly of W. T. Bruce and on the South and West by lands formerly of Azariah Woodson, as shown on the plat of J. M. Cox, Surveyor, dated Oct. 24, 1907.
