| All the right, title and interest of the minor Defendants, Doris Sherman, Jahue Sherman, Margaret Sherman and Thomas Franklin Sherman, in and to the following described real estate: |
| "All that piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being in Fair-view Township, County and State aforecaid, containing 50 acres, more or less, and being originally composed of two tracts of 25 acres each with |

one of these having been conveyed to Ben Sherman by Mamie Holcombe by deed dated April 6, 1946, recorded in Deed Book 259, Page 292. and the
