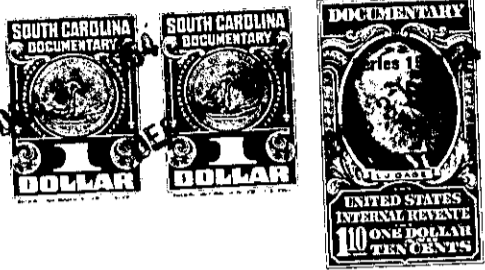

his heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 20 as shown  
on a Plat made by T. T. Dill, surveyor, June 1947 and recorded in  
the R.M.C. Office for Greenville, South Carolina in Plat Book \_\_\_\_\_  
at page \_\_\_\_\_ this being the property of the granter and being more
