

The State of South Carolina, EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, PALMER COVIL of Greenville, South Carolina T. J. CASH, JR. of Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 30th day of December, 19 54, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given. SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is COVIL INSULATION COMPANY THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to conduct an industrial insulation business; to buy, sell engineer, install and service industrial and commercial heating, air conditioning and ventilating equipment; to buy, sell, own, exchange, operate, mortgage, lease and manage real and personal property of all kinds, both as principal and agent and at either wholesale or retail; to do all things incident or necessary to such businesses, and in general carry on any business not contrary to the laws of the State of South Carolina; and to have and to exercise all the powers, rights, and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina upon corporations organized thereunder.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Seventy-five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars of which \$40,000.00 has been subscribed payable at the call of the Board of Directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is 750 Shares of the par value of \$100.00 Dollars each

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 29th day of November, 19 54, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Palmer Covil, Geneva B. Covil and T. J. Cash, Jr and Bertha M. Fortune

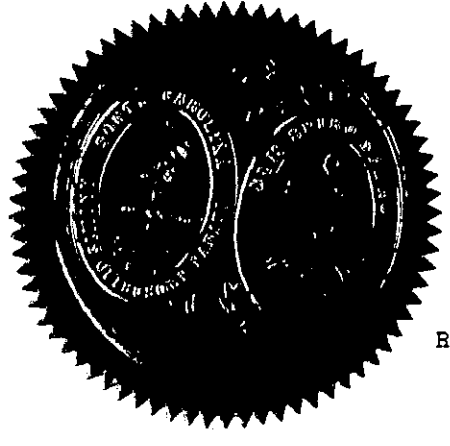
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Palmer Covil as Vice-President, T. J. Cash, Jr. as Secretary, T. J. Cash, Jr. as Treasurer, Palmer Covil

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
