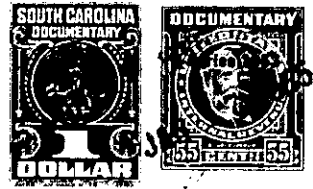

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Cora Harrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and No/100 Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Eric H. Plumbley (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eric H. Plumbley and her Heirs and Assigns Forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina lying on the north side of Highway No. 11 and bounded on west by land of Allie Bowers Sloan, on North by land of Mildred Pruitt, on east by land of Granter and contains one and 6/10 Acres, more or less, having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning a Stone in old Road, known as the Dividing Water Road, (now highway #11) on Allie B. Sloan's line and running with her line N 13-00 W 503 to iron pin; thence N 22 W 35 feet to stake in old road (leading to the Geo. Odum house); thence N 86 E 127 feet to point in road, marked by iron Pipe on east bank of road; thence S 24° 55' E 239.5 along road as property line and S 3° 25 W 300 feet along road as property line to point in old Highway No. 11; thence N 85-00 W 90 feet to beginning Corner.
